OSHA 10-HOUR MANDATED SAFETY TRAINING

This is a 10-hour safety training course that satisfies the newly established law requiring all workers on prevailing rate jobs over \$250,000.00 to have this class as mandated minimum training. The new law took effect July 18, 2008. It will provide the 10 hours of required training which includes an introduction to OSHA's health and safety standards for the construction industry. The program is tailored to first line supervisors, foreman, and workers responsible for, and involved in, construction field operations. Participants will be instructed on the basics of understanding, interpreting, and knowing how to use OSHA Construction Standards.
